Quality of Training and Student Support

AeroGuard offers a first-class training environment that creates professional pilots at an accelerated rate through a fully optimized curriculum built on feedback from airlines, instructors, and education professionals. AeroGuard's open door policy and focus on student success ensures every student has what they need to be successful. Some of the key factors in the quality of your training include:

- » **Low student to instructor ratios** for individualized attention.
- » **Training Oversight** – Flight Instructors are mentored by Training Managers who report to Team Leaders - a model aligned with the airlines to develop both student and instructor pilots in a culture that puts quality and safety above all else.
- » **Standardized AOM/GOM** – AeroGuard's General and Aircraft Operating Manuals ensure consistent standards, procedures, quality and safety.

Safety

AeroGuard has made a promise in Setting a Higher Standard in everything we do, and safety is no different. We pride ourselves on a number of unique safety measures which include:

- ✔ **A Safety Management System (SMS)** - based on an operating excellence and continuous improvement model that uses statistical process control.
- ✔ **Duty CFI** - A quality control check to ensure the safety monitoring and regulatory compliance of students conducting solo flights. Basically, your co-pilot on the ground.
- ✔ **Safety Stop Program** - a company policy encouraging all students and company personnel to put a "STOP" to operations whenever a risk to safety is observed.
- ✔ **"Just Culture"** - an all employee involvement policy in which voluntary reporting of safety concerns or deviations are strongly encouraged from everyone.



Expert Maintenance

Our **24-hour on-site maintenance team** ensures that planes are in top-notch shape prior to all flights. Life as a Student

Every day we set a higher standard for our students through culture, academics and commitment to our students' success. Our primary objective is to give students all the tools they need to thrive in their training.

Day in the Life of a Student

Each day is different depending on the student's schedule, but each student is typically on campus 6 days a week and has a 10-hour duty day. Here is what a typical day as a pilot in training could entail:

Student arrives at their home airport, checks in and files paperwork online for their mission

Briefing time is next. The student and their CFI will go over all details of their mission to ensure they understand what needs to happen during the mission.

Take off! Together the student and CFI will run a flight mission either in the air or in the simulator and polish their flying skills

After the mission it is time to debrief. The student and instructor will head back to a briefing room to discuss the outcome of the flight. There they will discuss tasks that were performed well and those that need some work. The purpose of the debrief is for the student to develop a clear picture of areas to study in preparation for the next mission.

Now it's time for ground school. Lecture based ground schools will regularly be scheduled to assist students in studying and developing their knowledge of the next concept they will need to master. If enrolled in a Part 61 program, ground school will be completed online at the student's own pace.

Student Housing

AeroGuard can provide student housing for students during their time in the U.S.A., with apartment facilities located close to each of our campuses. Apartment rooms are fully furnished, and college dormitory-style shared with other students enrolled at AeroGuard.

Although apartment facilities vary by location, they typically include the following:

Transportation

Transportation services may also be available between the apartment housing and flight training campus, running regularly throughout the day between the two locations for students coming and going to class and scheduled flights at all hours of the day.
